

# Related Work

Mr. Benjamin Page is a practicing designer in the fields of architecture and design.

In the past he has painted, drawn and sculpted, with most of his art in the earlier period of his life focused on self-expression and as reflections of his unique personal experiences. In the last 8 years, Mr. Page's passion lay in the field of architecture and design. He has accomplished many different projects, including several design projects that are tied in with nature both conceptually and physically.

The sample of work shown in this package depicts some of his architectural works that are closely related to nature:

**The Garden. Restaurant** (slides 1 through 5): A proposed restaurant space in a low-rise building in the heart of Los Angeles. The concept is to have actual producing garden spaces intertwined with the building and the dining space. The garden itself not only serves as food production, but also as a design feature that pulls people into a morphed space that blurs the distinction between the urban environment and nature, making a dining experience like no other.

**Wenzel's Residence** (slide 6 through 8): A residential interior renovation that was inspired by the conditions found in nature, even though the finished interior does not mimic nature physically. The conceptual ideas of layering, obstruction and segmentation inspired him while on vacation in the forests of Northern California, and are strongly embedded in the design of this work.
